COMMUNICATION...WHAT'S THAT?

Well, it is a hard word to define. Look it up in Webster and he really confuses the issue. "Communicate: 1) to share, 2) to make known, 3) to receive communion, 4) to have communication, 5) to join or connect. Communicate implies making common to all what one presently possesses." No wonder we have trouble communicating, we have trouble really defining it.

One thing that shows up in all of my pre-marriage counseling sessions with couples (post marriage as well) is the trouble they have communicating. I explain that 80% of their arguments will immerge because of a lack of communication. Next in line is money, and most of those because of not communicating about money. For the most part, it ends up being the fiancée can't get the groom to listen. Go figure; sorry ladies, it is our nature. I work a lot with couples; probably 50% of the time dealing in the area of communication. Most of that is trying to teach the groom "how" to listen. I explain to him it is not his nature and he must work harder at it; but the rewards are worth it. It is not easy for us men. We can go out and kill a deer and skin it, cut it up in pieces and put it in the freezer without communicating about it. Then the wife says "I didn't know you were going to do that." We think: "Hunting license, boots, gun in hand: What did you think I was going to do?" Communication.

Another thing I have found is that often, not always, the longer couples are married, the less they communicate. They have been together so long, they think they don't have to work at talking. But what happens so often when people have a disagreement is they stop talking to each other; lack of communication. If that is the case, why do I continue to hear from couples that the other one "just doesn't understand"? Husbands say: "I am tired of listening to her" while "the wife "is tired of telling him." All the time they simply exist, while never communicating their greatest heartfelt needs, because they think they have been married so long there is not much more to say.

Well I said all that to say this: If we think communication with our spouse is difficult, and we look at them face to face every day, why do we think we don't have to work at communication with God? If I can't figure out what my wife wants for her birthday, why should it be easy to figure out what God wants to do with my life? Communication. How do we communicate with God? Well, we spend time in His Word; that is God talking to us. We spend time talking in prayer; that is us communicating with God. We spend time listening during prayer, that is God communicating with us. We spend time in worship, that is us and God communicating with each other.

An older couple were talking one day. "Honey", the wife asked, "Do you love me?" The husband replied: "I told you I did when we got married 50 years ago and if I ever change my mind I will tell you". Sometimes Christians adapt that attitude with God. We think we are saved so we don't need to read our Bibles or spend time in prayer. We enjoyed the honeymoon, now is just the time in-between. After all, if God has something He wants to say, He should say it. God's reply would be: "But you're not listening." Many a Christian has fallen into an ego trap; they think because of being a Christian for so long that they have heard it all and have nothing more to learn. I bet you would never dream of telling that to your spouse, why imply that toward God? What results in a husband and wife is a dry crusty marriage waiting for each other to die of old age. Well, that is exactly what can happen in our relationship with God. Are you still communicating with God or is your relationship dry and crusty? If we only spent as much time communicating with God as we do with our spouse. What a wonderful relationship we would have with God. Don't simply exist and never communicate your greatest heartfelt needs to God or fail to hear God's greatest heartfelt needs to you. Pick up the phone, His Word and Prayer. He is waiting to communicate with you.

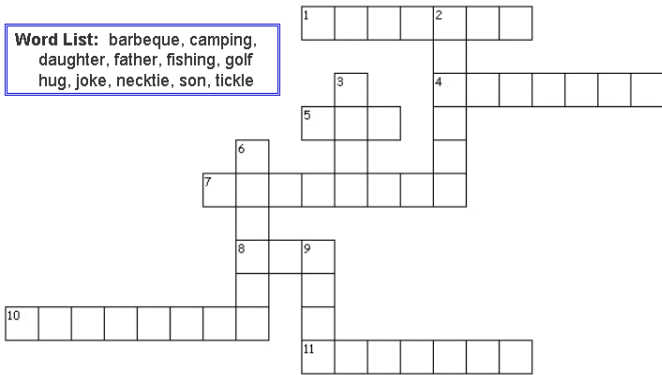
